Career Tech Scholarship Program Guidelines

- Must have graduated from a partner high school (or completed home school in PTC's district) in the past two years.
- Complete an application for admission to PTC
- Provide evidence of good attendance while in high school
- Provide a copy of your final high school transcript with 2.5+ GPA
- Write a brief essay about your career plans
- Fulfill all other PTC admission requirements

Benefits of attending PTC after high school graduation include:

3. College credits for most programs
4. Attend full or part time
5. Advanced standing toward additional education and training
6. Approved full time accredited programs qualify for Federal Financial Aid assistance

For full time students attending six hours a day, the scholarship value is the cost of tuition for the program for which you are applying. This will vary according to the program and program length but can range from \$0 to \$4100.

Three adult programs (Practical Nursing, Paramedic, Advanced Firefighter) are not available for part time attendance. For part time attendance the student may need to spend two years to complete the program depending upon whether they have attended the technology center or another technology center during high school.

Career Tech Scholarship applicants must apply within the first or second year after graduating high school.
